- What is a model-area, and their ecosystem/system structures, for integrated healthcare and social care?
- Presentation of 5-8 Nordic existing model-areas, and their ecosystems/system structures.
- Expected to be launch 8th of September 2022









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Objective 3: Develop (min) 5 areas towards integrated healthcare and care provision, underpinned by distance spanning solutions.

Through calls, model areas will be identified that wish to develop their integrated healthcare and care options.

Support will be considered for development of ecosystem components, outlined in objective 1, as well as models of integrated management of health data according to objective 2.

The aim is to match each model area supported, with model areas described in objective 1 for network and support.
