


Bornholm





Bornholms Regionskommune and Bornholms Hospital Numbers (2023)

- > 39.337 Citizens (decreasing)
- 12.139 Citizens ≥65 years of age (increasing)
- ➤ 32.005 contacts and 2.712 citizens with connections to municipal services (ex. nursing homes)
- > 490 somatic readmissions
- > 815 preventable hospital stays (SDS SundhedsDataStyrelsen)
- > 7400 admissions
- ➤ 46.700 outpatient visits
- 220 helicopter flights
- ➤ 112 acute ambulance transports (off the island)
- ➤ 40.700 single overseas patienttransports



Challenges

- Shortness in healthcare workers alongside with a decrease in healthcare students

- Difference in legislations internally and across sectors
- Documentation and GDPR across sectors
- Geographical challenges




Interventions

- Cross sectoral strategy for Nursing Care (iHAC)




Cross sectoral Strategy for Personcentered Nursing Care


Activities
